

PROVINCIAL INTER-PROVINCIAL CAMP

Requirements

1. Girls must meet required pre-requisites (ie. age, skill level).
2. Any girl who was a delegate at an Inter-provincial Camp the previous year may not apply Inter-provincially the following year. (Policy, Spring Council – 1990_
3. Applications must be complete to be considered. No faxes will be accepted.
4. Complete applications must arrive prior to or by the deadline date to be considered.
5. Girls must prepare their own letter of application.
6. If a relative is the applicant's Guider, an assistant Guider shall complete the recommendation forms.
7. Applications shall be forwarded to the provincial Office through the Area/Division Camping Adviser to ensure all required information is included. The deadline for Camp Advisers to receive completed applications shall be one week prior to the Provincial deadline.
8. Delegates selected for an Inter-national, Inter-provincial or Provincial Camp in the same year will be given the option of deciding which ONE they wish to attend.

PROCESS

1. The selection committee chairperson will screen all applications to ensure the requirements are met.
2. Each application will be given a number by the chairperson. No names will be used during the reading of the applications.
3. The chairperson will read each complete application to a committee of three to five people who will evaluate each application on a predetermined point system. The system is to be based on specific requirements of the particular camp (ie. Wilderness, basic).
4. The application(s) with the highest points will be selected. The number of delegates is dependent on the number invited.
5. The next two (2) highest applications will become the alternates.
6. All alternates will receive pre-camp information and attend the briefing.
7. All applicants will receive written confirmation of the selection results from the Provincial Inter-provincial Coordinator.
8. All applicants will be asked to pay their portion of camp fee and airfare fees prior to the camping event to Nova Scotia Council.
