


















































Fund Raising Do's & Don'ts

- DO -  Complete a Fund Raising Motion form.
- DO -  Ensure all procedures in Safe Guide are met.
- DO -  Get approval from the Communications Advisory Committee if using GGC Logos on items for sale.
- DO -  Submit the form to the appropriate Council for review and approval prior to the event:
 - o Units, Parent Groups and Local Associations must get approval from the District Council or, in the absence of a District Council, Area Council.
 - o District Fund Raising requests must get approval from Area Council.
 - o Area Council Fund Raising requests must get approval from Provincial Council





















DON'T  Start your fund raising event until you have received approval to proceed.
